

Background: Anti-Rat IgG F(c) generated in goat is a proteolytic fragment of immunoglobulin G (IgG) obtained by limited digestion with the enzyme papain under controlled conditions of temperature, time and pH . Receptors bind the Fc portion of rat IgG and often this fragment is removed from immunoglobulins to minimize receptor binding and lower background reactivity.

Application Note: This product has been assayed against 1.0 μ g of Rat IgG in a standard capture ELISA using Peroxidase Conjugated Streptavidin #S000-03 and ABTS (2,2'-azino-bis-[3-ethylbenthiazoline-6-sulfonic acid]) code # ABTS-100 as a substrate for 30 minutes at room temperature. A working dilution of 1:4,000 to 1:20,000 of the reconstitution concentration is suggested for this product.



Image 1. Western Blot of Anti-Rat IgG F(c) (GOAT) Antibody . Lane M: 3 μl Molecular Ladder. Lane 1: Rat IgG whole molecule . Lane 2: Rat IgG F(c) Fragment . Lane 3: Rat IgG Fab Fragment . Lane 4: Rat IgM Whole Molecule . Lane 5: Rat Serum . All samples were reduced. Load: 50 ng per lane. Block: ABIN925618 for 30 min at RT. Primary Antibody: Anti-Rat IgG F(c) (GOAT) Antibody 1:1,000 for 60 min at RT. Secondary Antibody: Anti-Goat IgG (DONKEY) Peroxidase Conjugated Antibody 1:40,000 in ABIN925618 for 30 min at RT. Predicted/Obsevered Size: 25 and 55 kDa for Rat IgG and Serum, 25 kDa for F(c) and Fab, 78 and 25 kDa for IgM. Rat F(c) migrates slightly higher.
