Background: Synonyms: Actin related protein 2/3 complex subunit 5 16 kD, Actin related protein 2/3 complex subunit 5, Actin related protein 2/3 complex, subunit 5 16 kDa, Actin-related protein 2/3 complex subunit 5, ARC16, Arp2/3 complex 16 kDa subunit, Arp2/3 protein complex subunit p16, Actin-related protein 2/3, ARPC 5, Arpc5, ARPC5_HUMAN, p16 Arc, p16-ARC.

Background: This gene encodes one of seven subunits of the human Arp2/3 protein complex. The Arp2/3 protein complex has been implicated in the control of actin polymerization in cells and has been conserved through evolution. The exact role of the protein encoded by this gene, the p16 subunit, has yet to be determined. Alternatively spliced transcript variants encoding different isoforms have been observed for this gene
