Background: Synonyms: GABA, GABAA receptor subunit beta-2, GABRB2, Gamma aminobutyric acid GABA A receptor, beta 2, Gamma aminobutyric acid A receptor beta 2, Gamma-aminobutyric acid receptor subunit beta-2, Gamma-aminobutyric-acid receptor subunit beta-2, GBRB2_HUMAN, Background: GAD-65 and GAD-67, glutamate decarboxylases, function to catalyze the production of GABA (gamma-aminobutyric acid). In the central nervous system GABA functions as the main inhibitory transmitter by increasing a Cl⁻ conductance that inhibits neuronal firing. GABA has been shown to activate both ionotropic (GABAA) and metabotropic (GABAB) receptors as well as a third class of receptors called GABAC. Both GABAA and GABAC are ligand-gated ion channels, however, they are structurally and functionally distinct.
