Background: Synonyms: mitochondrial, CI-39kD, Complex I subunit NDUFA9, Complex I-39kD, NADH dehydrogenase [ubiquinone] 1 alpha subcomplex subunit 9, NADH dehydrogenase [ubiquinone] 1 alpha subcomplex subunit 9 mitochondrial, NADH Ubiquinone Oxidoreductase 1 alpha subcomplex 9, NADH-Ubiquinone Oxidoreductase 1 alpha subcomplex 9, NADH-ubiquinone oxidoreductase 39 kDa subunit, NDUA9_HUMAN, NDUFA9.

Background: Accessory subunit of the mitochondrial membrane respiratory chain NADH dehydrogenase (Complex I), that is believed not to be involved in catalysis. Complex I functions in the transfer of electrons from NADH to the respiratory chain. The immediate electron acceptor for the enzyme is believed to be ubiquinone.
