The gene encoding NET-6 maps to human chromosome 7, which houses over 1,000 genes, comprises nearly 5 % of the human genome and has been linked to Osteogenesis imperfecta, Pendred syndrome, Lissencephaly, Citrullinemia and Shwachman-Diamond syndrome.
