Format: Liquid

Buffer: Supplied as solution form in PBS, pH7.4, containing 0.02 % NaN<sub>3</sub>, 50 % glycerol.

---

Preservative: Sodium azide

---

Precaution of Use: **WARNING:** Reagents contain sodium azide. Sodium azide is very toxic if ingested or inhaled. Avoid contact with skin, eyes, or clothing. Wear eye or face protection when handling. If skin or eye contact occurs, wash with copious amounts of water. If ingested or inhaled, contact a physician immediately. Sodium azide yields toxic hydrazoic acid under acidic conditions. Handling Advice: Avoid repeated freeze/thaw cycles

Storage: 4 °C

---

Storage Comment: Store at 2-8 °C for one month. Aliquot and store at -80 °C for 12 months.
