CDK5RAP1 contains one TRAM domain, which is thought to bind tRNA and deliver the RNA-modifying enzymatic domain to its target. There are 4 named isoforms of CDK5RAP1 that are produced as a result of alternative splicing events and are expressed at high levels in heart and skeletal muscle.
