Background:	Cytochrome P450 2C40 (EC 1.14.14.-) (CYPIIC40),FUNCTION: A cytochrome P450 monooxygenase that may play a major role in the metabolism of arachidonic acid in the intestinal tract (PubMed:10908295, PubMed:9721182). Exhibits regioselective hydroxylase and epoxidase activity toward arachidonic acid, producing 16(R)-hydroxyeicosatetraenoic acid (HETE) and (14R,15S)-epoxyeicosatrienoic acid (EpETrE) as major products (PubMed:10908295). Mechanistically, uses molecular oxygen inserting one oxygen atom into a substrate, and reducing the second into a water molecule, with two electrons provided by NADPH via cytochrome P450 reductase (CPR, NADPH-ferrihemoprotein reductase) (PubMed:10908295). {ECO:0000269 PubMed:10908295, ECO:0000269 PubMed:9721182}.
