The protein's absorbance will be measured in several dilutions and is measured against its specific reference buffer.

The concentration of our recombinant proteins is measured using the absorbance at 280nm.

The concentration of the protein is calculated using its specific absorption coefficient. We use the Expasy's protparam tool to determine the absorption coefficient of each protein.

#### Purification:

Two step purification of proteins expressed in bacterial culture:

- 1. In a first purification step, the protein is purified from the cleared cell lysate using three different His-tag capture materials: high yield, EDTA resistant, or DTT resistant. Eluate fractions are analyzed by SDS-PAGE.
- 2. Protein containing fractions of the best purification are subjected to second purification step through size exclusion chromatography. Eluate fractions are analyzed by SDS-PAGE and Western blot.

Background:	G-protein coupled receptor for 5-hydroxytryptamine (serotonin). Also functions as a receptor for
	various drugs and psychoactive substances. Ligand binding causes a conformation change
	that triggers signaling via guanine nucleotide-binding proteins (G proteins) and modulates the
	activity of down-stream effectors, such as adenylate cyclase. Beta-arrestin family members

	inhibit signaling via G proteins and mediate activation of alternative signaling pathways.
	Signaling inhibits adenylate cyclase activity and activates a phosphatidylinositol-calcium
	second messenger system that regulates the release of $Ca(2+)$ ions from intracellular stores.
	Plays a role in the regulation of 5-hydroxytryptamine release and in the regulation of dopamine
	and 5-hydroxytryptamine metabolism. Plays a role in the regulation of dopamine and 5-
	hydroxytryptamine levels in the brain, and thereby affects neural activity, mood and behavior.
