Background:	Aflatoxins are naturally occurring mycotoxins that are produced by many species of <i>Aspergillus</i> . Aflatoxins are toxic and among the most carcinogenic substances known. Crops which are frequently affected by <i>Aspergillus</i> include cereals (maize, sorghum, pearl millet, rice, wheat), oilseeds (peanut, soybean, sunflower, cotton), spices (chile peppers, black pepper, coriander, turmeric, ginger), and tree nuts (almond, pistachio, walnut, coconut, brazil nut).
