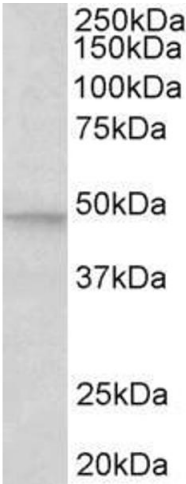

Image 1. ABIN5539691 (0.5µg/ml) staining of Human Cerebellum lysate (35µg protein in RIPA buffer). Primary incubation was 1 hour. Detected by chemiluminescence.
