The loss rate of this kit is less than 5 % within the expiration date under appropriate storage condition. To minimize extra influence on the performance, operation procedures and lab conditions, especially room temperature, air humidity, incubator temperature should be strictly controlled. It is also strongly suggested that the whole assay is performed by the same operator from the beginning to the end. Assay Time: 3 h Pre-coated Plate: Protocol: The test principle applied in this kit is Sandwich enzyme immunoassay. The microtiter plate provided in this kit has been pre-coated with an antibody specific to Aminoadipate Semialdehyde Phosphopantetheinyl Transferase (AASDHPPT). Standards or samples are then added to the appropriate microtiter plate wells with a biotin-conjugated antibody specific to Aminoadipate Semialdehyde Phosphopantetheinyl Transferase (AASDHPPT). Next, Avidin conjugated to Horseradish Peroxidase (HRP) is added to each microplate well and incubated. After TMB substrate solution is added, only those wells that contain Aminoadipate Semialdehyde Phosphopantetheinyl Transferase (AASDHPPT), biotin-conjugated antibody and enzyme-conjugated Avidin will exhibit a change in color. The enzyme-substrate reaction is terminated by the addition of sulphuric acid solution and the color change is measured spectrophotometrically at a wavelength of 450nm ± 10nm. The concentration of Aminoadipate Semialdehyde Phosphopantetheinyl Transferase (AASDHPPT) in the samples is then determined by comparing the O.D. of the samples to the standard curve. Assay Precision:

Aminoadipate Semialdehyde Phosphopantetheinyl Transferase (AASDHPPT) were tested 20
times on one plate, respectively
Inter-assay Precision (Precision between assays): 3 samples with low, middle and high level
Aminoadipate Semialdehyde Phosphopantetheinyl Transferase (AASDHPPT) were tested on 3
different plates, 8 replicates in each plate. CV(%) = SD/meanX100
