The loss rate of this kit is less than 5 % within the expiration date under appropriate storage condition. To minimize extra influence on the performance, operation procedures and lab conditions, especially room temperature, air humidity, incubator temperature should be strictly controlled. It is also strongly suggested that the whole assay is performed by the same operator from the beginning to the end. Assay Time: 3 h Pre-coated Plate: Protocol: The test principle applied in this kit is Sandwich enzyme immunoassay. The microtiter plate provided in this kit has been pre-coated with an antibody specific to Spermidine/Spermine N1-Acetyltransferase 1 (SAT1). Standards or samples are then added to the appropriate microtiter plate wells with a biotin-conjugated antibody specific to Spermidine/Spermine N1-Acetyltransferase 1 (SAT1). Next, Avidin conjugated to Horseradish Peroxidase (HRP) is added to each microplate well and incubated. After TMB substrate solution is added, only those wells that contain Spermidine/Spermine N1-Acetyltransferase 1 (SAT1), biotin-conjugated antibody and enzyme-conjugated Avidin will exhibit a change in color. The enzyme-substrate reaction is terminated by the addition of sulphuric acid solution and the color change is measured spectrophotometrically at a wavelength of $450 \text{nm} \pm 10 \text{nm}$. The concentration of Spermidine/Spermine N1-Acetyltransferase 1 (SAT1) in the samples is then determined by comparing the O.D. of the samples to the standard curve.
