The loss rate of this kit is less than Comment: 5 % within the expiration date under appropriate storage condition. To minimize extra influence on the performance, operation procedures and lab conditions, especially room temperature, air humidity, incubator temperature should be strictly controlled. It is also strongly suggested that the whole assay is performed by the same operator from the beginning to the end. 3 h Assay Time: Plate: Pre-coated Protocol: The test principle applied in this kit is Sandwich enzyme immunoassay. The microtiter plate provided in this kit has been pre-coated with an antibody specific to Transient Receptor Potential Cation Channel Subfamily M, Member 4 (TRPM4). Standards or samples are then added to the appropriate microtiter plate wells with a biotin-conjugated antibody specific to Transient Receptor Potential Cation Channel Subfamily M, Member 4 (TRPM4). Next, Avidin conjugated to Horseradish Peroxidase (HRP) is added to each microplate well and incubated. After TMB substrate solution is added, only those wells that contain Transient Receptor Potential Cation Channel Subfamily M, Member 4 (TRPM4), biotin-conjugated antibody and enzyme-conjugated Avidin will exhibit a change in color. The enzyme-substrate reaction is terminated by the addition of sulphuric acid solution and the color change is measured spectrophotometrically at a wavelength of 450nm ± 10nm. The concentration of Transient Receptor Potential Cation Channel Subfamily M, Member 4 (TRPM4) in the samples is then determined by comparing the O.D. of the samples to the standard curve. Assay Precision: Intra-assay Precision (Precision within an assay): 3 samples with low, middle and high level Transient Receptor Potential Cation Channel Subfamily M, Member 4 (TRPM4) were tested 20

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different plates, 8 replicates in each plate. CV(%) = SD/meanX100

Inter-assay Precision (Precision between assays): 3 samples with low, middle and high level
