
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

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




**Image 1.** ABIN6274953 staining Hela by IF/ICC. The sample were fixed with PFA and permeabilized in 0.1% Triton X-100,then blocked in 10% serum for 45 minutes at 25<sub>i</sub>ãC. The primary antibody was diluted at 1/200 and incubated with the sample for 1 hour at 37<sub>i</sub>ãC. An Alexa Fluor 594 conjugated goat anti-rabbit IgG (H+L) Ab, diluted at 1/600, was used as the secondary antibod

**Image 2.** ABIN6274953 at 1/100 staining Mouse liver tissue by IHC-P. The sample was formaldehyde fixed and a heat mediated antigen retrieval step in citrate buffer was performed. The sample was then blocked and incubated with the antibody for 1.5 hours at 22<sub>j</sub>ãC. An HRP conjugated goat anti-rabbit antibody was used as the secondary
