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
Plate: Protocol:	<ul> <li>Pre-coated</li> <li>1. Prepare all reagents, samples and standards,</li> <li>2. Add 100µL standard or sample to each well. Incubate 1 hours at 37 °C,</li> <li>3. Aspirate and add 100µL prepared Detection Reagent A. Incubate 1 hour at 37 °C,</li> <li>4. Aspirate and wash 3 times,</li> <li>5. Add 100µL prepared Detection Reagent B. Incubate 30 minutes at 37 °C,</li> <li>6. Aspirate and wash 5 times,</li> <li>7. Add 90µL Substrate Solution. Incubate 10-20 minutes at 37 °C,</li> </ul>

Comment:	Information on standard material:		
	<ul> <li>parameter setting for the plate reader may lead to incorrect results. A microplate plate reader with a bandwidth of 10nm or less and an optical density range of 0-3 O.D. or greater at 450 ± 10nm wavelength is acceptable for use in absorbance measurement. Please read the instruction carefully and adjust the instrument prior to the experiment.</li> <li>Even the same operator might get different results in two separate experiments. In order to get better reproducible results, the operation of every step in the assay should be controlled. Furthermore, a preliminary experiment before assay for each batch is recommended.</li> <li>Each kit has been strictly passed Q.C test. However, results from end users might be inconsistent with our in-house data due to some unexpected transportation conditions or different lab equipments. Intra-assay variance among kits from different results, since we have not compared our products with other manufacturers.</li> </ul>		

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Reagent Preparation:	<ol> <li>Bring all kit components and samples to room temperature (18-25 °C) before use. If the kit is not used up all at once, remove only the strips and reagents for the current experiment and leave the remaining strips and reagents in the desired condition.</li> <li>Standard - Reconstitute the standard with the Standard Diluent, keep it at room temperature for 10 minutes and shake it gently (do not let it foam). Please prepare tubes with Standard Diluent and make a dilution series. Mix each tube thoroughly before the next transfer. The last tube with Standard Diluent is the blank as 0 mg/mL.</li> <li>Detection Reagent A and Detection Reagent B - Spin or centrifuge the stock of Detection Reagent A and B briefly before use. Dilute to working concentration (1:100) with Assay Diluent A or B, respectively.</li> <li>Wash Solution - Dilute 20 mL of Wash Solution Concentrate (30x) with 580 mL of deionized or distilled water to make 600 mL of Wash Solution (1x).</li> <li>TMB Substrate - Aspirate the required amount of solution with sterile tip and do not return the residual solution back into the vial.</li> </ol>

	<ol> <li>Detection Reagent A and B are sticky solutions, so pipette them slowly to reduce volume errors.</li> </ol>
	<ul> <li>4. Reconstitute Standard or working solutions of Detection Reagent A and B carefully according to instructions, avoiding foaming and mixing gently until crystals are completely dissolved. To minimize inaccuracy caused by pipetting, use small volumes and ensure pipettes are calibrated. It is recommended to aspirate more than 10 μL for one-time pipetting.</li> <li>5. Sample Preparation:	<ul> <li>It is recommended to use fresh samples without long storage, otherwise protein degradation and denaturationmay occur in these samples, leading to false results. Samples should therefore be stored for a short periodat 2 - 8 °C or aliquoted at -20 °C (≤1 month) or -80 °C (≤ 3 months). Repeated freeze-thawcycles should be avoided. Prior to assay, the frozen samples should be slowly thawed and centrifuged toremove precipitates.</li> <li>If the sample type is not specified in the instructions, a preliminary test is necessary to determinecompatibility with the kit.</li> <li>If a lysis buffer is used to prepare tissue homogenates or cell culture supernatant, there is a possibility of causing a deviation due to the introduced chemical substance. 
