It is a member of Immunoglobulin (Ig) superfamily. CD56 and CD16 expressing lymphocytes are primarily considered as human NK cells and NK-T cells. A subset of CD56+ NK cells plays a unique functional role in the innate immune response as the primary source of NK cell-derived immunoregulatory cytokines, regulated in part by differential monokine production. CD56 is expressed in normal and as well as neoplastic human neuroendocrine tissues, certain large granular lymphocyte (LGL) leukemias, small-cell lung carcinomas, neuronal derived tumors,
