Background:	Synonyms: IFNA, IFN-a, IFN-α, Interferon alpha, Interferon-alpha, IFNA1, IFNA13, IFNA1/13, IFNA4: IFNA5, IFNA6, IFNA17, IFNA21, IFNA8, IFNA2, IFNA7, IFNA14, IFNA10, IFNA16, Pan Interferon alpha Background: Interferon-α (IFN-α, also known as IFN-alpha, IFN-a, IFNA and Interferon-alpha) is a type I interferon and exists as 13 subtypes: IFN-α 1, 2, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 10, 13, 14, 16, 17 and 21. They are mainly produced by virus-infected cells after sensing the presence of danger signals such as viral DNA or RNA. The binding of IFN-α to its receptor initiates an anti-viral response, but also anti-tumor effects have been shown. A key producer of type I interferons is the plasmacytoid dendritic cell.
