Background: Rab1A is mostly found in the membrane of the endoplasmic reticulum (ER) and Golgi apparatus and is involved in cell signaling, cancer, and neurodegenerative diseases (1). It regulates protein transport from the ER to the Golgi compartment and is involved in growth hormone secretion (2)., cellular localisation: Cytoplasm , Endoplasmic reticulum , Endosome , Golgi apparatus , Membrane

Application Notes: WB (1:1000), optimal dilutions for assays should be determined by the user.

Comment: A 1:1000 dilution was sufficient for detection of RAB1A in 10 ug (A549, MEF), 20 ug (Mouse Brain) lysates by ECL immunoblot analysis.
