Gephyrin catalyzes two steps in the biosynthesis of the molybdenum cofactor. In the first step, molybdopterin is adenylated. Subsequently, molybdate is inserted into adenylated molybdopterin and AMP is release [taken from the Universal Protein Resource (UniProt) Q9NQX3].
