Background: 4-galactosyl-N-acetylglucosaminide 3-alpha-L-fucosyltransferase 9 (EC 2.4.1.152) (Fucosyltransferase 9) (Fucosyltransferase IX) (Fuc-TIX) (FucT-IX) (Galactoside 3-L-fucosyltransferase), FUNCTION: Catalyzes alpha(1->3) linkage of fucosyl moiety transferred from GDP-beta-L-fucose to N-acetyl glucosamine (GlcNAc) within type 2 lactosamine (LacNAc, beta-D-Gal-(1->4)-beta-D-GlcNAc-) glycan attached to glycolipids and N- or O-linked glycoproteins.
