Fibroblast growth factor 13 (FGF-13) (Fibroblast growth factor homologous factor 2) (FHF-2),FUNCTION: Microtubule-binding protein which directly binds tubulin and is involved in both polymerization and stabilization of microtubules (PubMed:22726441). Through its action on microtubules, may participate to the refinement of axons by negatively regulating axonal and leading processes branching (PubMed:22726441). Plays a crucial role in neuron polarization and migration in the cerebral cortex and the hippocampus (PubMed:22726441). Regulates voltage-gated sodium channel transport and function (PubMed:21817159). May also play a role in MAPK signaling (PubMed:11378392, PubMed:12244047). Required for the development of axonal initial segment-targeting inhibitory GABAergic synapses made by chandelier neurons (PubMed:30679375).
