Background:	B7y, B7H7, B7-H5, HHLA2 This gene encodes a protein ligand found on the surface of monocytes. The encoded protein is thought to regulate cell-mediated immunity by binding to a receptor on T lymphocytes and inhibiting the proliferation of these cells. Alternate splicing results in multiple transcript variants.

Molecular Weight: predicted molecular mass of 39.5 kDa after removal of the signal peptide. The apparent molecular mass of B7-H7(23-137)-hFc is 35-55 kDa due to glycosylation.

Application Notes: Extracellular Domain Proteins (ECD) can be used as:

Handling

Format: Lyophilized

Buffer: Lyophilized from sterile PBS, pH 7.4. Normally 5 % – 8% trehalose is added as protectants before lyophilization.

Storage: -20 °C, -80 °C

Storage Comment: Store at -20°C to -80°C for 12 months in lyophilized form. After reconstitution, if not intended for use within a month, aliquot and store at -80°C (Avoid repeated freezing and thawing).
Lyophilized proteins are shipped at ambient temperature.
