Could play a role in bone osteoclastic resorption. Cleaves KiSS1 at a Gly-I-Leu bond. Cleaves type IV and type V collagen into large C-terminal three quarter fragments and shorter N-terminal one quarter fragments. Degrades fibronectin but not laminin or Pz-peptide.
