Background:	<p>Endoglin (CD105) is a type I membrane glycoprotein located on cell surfaces and is part of the TGF beta receptor complex. The protein consists of a homodimer of 180 kDA with disulfide links. It has been found on endothelial cells, activated macrophages, fibroblasts, and smooth muscle cells. Endoglin has been found to be part of the TGF-beta1 receptor complex. It thus may be involved in the binding of TGF-beta1, TGF-beta3, activin-A, BMP-2, and BMP-7.</p> <p>Alternative Names: CD105, Endoglin protein, CD 105, CD 105 protein, CD-105, CD-105 protein</p>

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Format: Lyophilized

Buffer: Supplied as a lyophilized powder. Reconstitute by adding a carrier protein (e.g. 0.1 % HSA or BSA) which allows for long term storage.

Handling Advice: Avoid repeated freeze/thaw cycles.

Storage: -20 °C/-80 °C

Storage Comment: Store at -70 °C until reconstitution. Following reconstitution product should be aliquoted and frozen at -20 °C.
