
Background:	NR1H3 form a subfamily of the nuclear receptor superfamily and are key regulators of macrophage function, controlling transcriptional programs involved in lipid homeostasis and		
	inflammation. The inducible LXRA is highly expressed in liver, adrenal gland, intestine, adipose		
	tissue, macrophages, lung, and kidney, whereas LXRB is ubiquitously expressed. Ligand-		
	activated LXRs form obligate heterodimers with retinoid X receptors (RXRs, see MIM 180245)		
	and regulate expression of target genes containing LXR response elements. Synonyms: LXRA,		
	Liver X receptor alpha, Nuclear orphan receptor LXR-alpha, Nuclear receptor subfamily 1 group		
	H member 3, Oxysterols receptor LXR-alpha
